Policy for the Safeguarding and Protection of Children

The UK law defines a child as a person under the age of 18 years. The Association of Kent Veteran Golfers requires members to have achieved the age of 60.

In the event that children may be present in the clubhouse or on the course when we play a tournament at a Safe Golf Accredited golf club we undertake:

- a) to notify our members that our policy, which is set out in (b) and (c) below, is published and freely available on the association's website: (<u>www.akvg.com</u>).
- b) our policy is to require to see the policy for the Safeguarding and Protection of Children of each Safe Golf Accredited golf club that hosts one of our tournaments.
- c) our policy is to adopt and comply with the policy for the Safeguarding and Protection of Children of each Safe Golf Accredited golf club that hosts one of our tournaments.
